b. Approval of School Lunch Negative Balance Procedure

Lori Miller reported a negative balance in the school lunch because people haven't paid for their lunches. There is a small reprieve at the high school with the threat of the diploma. There is host of issues with this negative balance. Miller reported two other towns have implemented a policy that seems to be working. Mary Anne Roll clarified this is procedure versus policy. Miller explained the policy says anyone can participate in the national school lunch program and you can go on line with either Pay Pal or a debit card and lower the student's lunch credit. The advantage is parents can see when they eat, the balance, if they are getting milk. If parents can't do that they can use a credit card. There is never an issue of a child not eating; they will be given a sandwich, fruit and milk. The first price point is ten dollars. Notification will go home in backpacks for elementary and mailed for middle and high schools. If the balance gets up to twenty dollars the student won't be allowed to participate in the program. It was suggested requiring that the parent return the form with a parent signature on the front page. Superintendent Fortunato stated she would bring the forms to Lonsdale today where they are having a kindergarten orientation and back to school social. Tomorrow the form can go to the high school and Thursday to Saylesville and Northern and the following week Central. Motion to approve the School Lunch Negative Balance Procedure by Lafleur.
