PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION MONTHLY MEETING

May 10, 2006

Meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. Commission members present were Chairman Kevin Bryson, Paul Hetu, Gerry Dumas, Erin Vaughan, Roy Coulombe and Gary Stott.

Reviewed previous minutes from April 12, 2006 meeting. Minutes of the April meeting were accepted as corrected.

Page 1, paragraph 6 to read as follows:

Lonsdale – Roy Coulombe – needs work – they are digging foundation for addition. Snack bar/press box should be demolished after this season and relocated. Should be coordinated with contractor now while he is on-site for next year.

Erin reported that a gas line and sewer line hit today. School evacuated.

Page 2, paragraph 5:

New Business: Motion by Roy Coulombe to recommend to the Town Council that they explore combining the construction documents, plans and bids of creating the two new all-purpose fields in Manville Park and the new practice field at Lincoln High School was approved.

Albion – Erin Vaughan – no changes to report. Waiting on Angell Road little league progress.

Manville – Gerard Dumas – Problem getting key to bathroom at park during a birthday party. Party called Gerry to unlock bathroom. He doesn't have a new key when lock was changed. Gerry called town hall twice to obtain a key with no results as of yet.

Fairlawn – Gary Stott – Skateboard park in good shape.

Basketball court in bad shape. Floods when rains.

Playground – Main piece of toddler play area roped off with plastic fensing and yellow tape as equipment is damaged. Gary showed photos of equipment roped off. Should be dismantled to avoid injury. Gary will call Paul Prackniak.

Limerock – no report.

Quinnville – Kevin Bryson – park gets a lot of use. Problem with lighting being on at different times.

Director's report:

Albion – Reviewed improvements needed. Need updates on expenditures for Limeacres, Manville and Albion from Paul Prackniak. Request report on meeting for middle school.
