PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION MONTHLY MEETING

September 13, 2006

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Commission members present were Chairman Kevin Bryson, Paul Hetu, Gerry Dumas, Roy Coulombe, Erin Vaughan, David Boyle and Gary Stott.

Reviewed previous minutes from August 9, 2006 meeting. Minutes of the August meeting were accepted as corrected.

Page 2, paragraph 1 to read as follows:

Old Business:

Angell Road little league field newspaper report. Discussion about allocation of money for parks and which parks will get lighting.

Reviewed as-built plans of Manville Park. Questioned the survey memo dated February 21, 2006 from Ben Gary indicating the hill removal up to 18'.

Commissioner's Reports:

Saylesville – Paul Hetu – nothing to report.

The chain should be replaced and locked and parents should be told not to drive on the access road, as kids are not expecting them to be driving there. Very dangerous situation.

Albion – Erin Vaughan – nothing to report.

Manville – Gerard Dumas – canopy needs work, paint peeling. Electrical post is tilting. Mentioned twice and needs to be reported as the post is near playground and is very dangerous. Outfield fencing falling apart. Picnic tables near the beach should be removed for the winter. Handicap bathrooms are not up to code. Need to have bathrooms inspected to see what the restrooms need. Gerry has been asked again for a key to the bathrooms and is still waiting to get a key.

Fairlawn – nothing to report.

Limerock – nothing to report.

Quinnville – Kevin Bryson – Grass needs cutting.

Director's report:

Kevin Bryson to call Paul about what new field layout does he mean? More info needed on surveying Albion Park plans. Who's paying surveyor? What is the budget? Need report on Albion. What are they surveying?
