### **PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION MONTHLY MEETING**

**December 10, 2008**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Commission members present were Chairman Kevin Bryson, Paul Hetu, Roy Coulombe and Gary Stott. Commission members absent from this meeting were Erin Vaughan, Robert Sylvestre and David Boyle.

The Commission members reviewed the minutes for the November 12, 2008 meeting. A motion was made by Member Roy Coulombe to accept the November 12, 2008 minutes and the motion was seconded by Member Gary Stott.

There have been no Director's Reports for the past four (4) months.

#### **Commissioner's Reports:**

**Saylesville – Paul Hetu – The equipment looks ok. Due to the time of year the park is not getting much use anymore.**

**Lonsdale – Roy Coulombe – Everything looks great. Installed beams for dugouts. He spoke with John Sharkey regarding the geese issue; hired a border collie to come daily onto the field to chase away the geese. The basketball net is still too high. Some drains are being added.**

**Albion – Erin Vaughan – No report.**

**Manville – Robert Sylvestre – No report.**

**Fairlawn – Gary Stott – Activity within the park is slowing down due to the colder weather.**

**Limerock – David Boyle – No report.**

**Quinnville – Kevin Bryson – The framework for the skating rink was setup about three weeks ago and now kids cannot play football on that field. Why stop usage of that field now? Leaves were picked up within the park. Everything looks good as a whole.**

#### **Old Business:**

**The Town Council named the Lonsdale Little League Field Randall C. “Randy” Hien Field.**

**The Commission members noted that there is an extra light left over from the Middle School; only three of the four lights were installed. A suggestion was made to make use of the light elsewhere such as at the High School.**

#### **New Business:**

**Commission member Roy Coulombe suggested adding some type of hockey to the Manville Park plans; either street hockey or ice hockey. The Commission members agreed that this would be an excellent idea but would have to look at the plans first.**
