

**The Warden's of the Saylesville Fire District met on July 10, 2014 at the Saylesville Fire Station. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Ernest Lacombe. Present were Deputy Chief Fisher, Wardens Ernest Lacombe, Craig Wilson, Robert Ferioli and David Sale. Also present was Treasurer Raymond Neves, Tax collector David Almond and Clerk Barbara Ferioli.**

**Motion was made by Robert Ferioli and seconded by David Sale to dispense with the reading of the June 10, 2014 minutes, Motion passed. Motion was made by Craig Wilson and seconded by David Sale to approve the minutes of the June 10, 2014 meeting. Motion passed.**

**Motion was made by Robert Ferioli and seconded by Craig Wilson to approve the monthly bills in the amount of \$18,059.79 Motion passed.**

**Treasurer Raymond Neves reported the total liquid assets of the Saylesville Fire District are \$171,587.52. The last reconciliation of the Blackstone River Federal Credit Unnion account was as of May 31, 2014 and the Citizens account was as of June 30, 2014 with no discrepancies in the account. Motion to approve the report by David Sale and seconded by Craig Wilson. Motion passed.**

**Tax Collector David Almond reported that \$23,292.59 had been collected between June 13, 2014 and July 10, 2014 and \$145,980.63**

**was collected between July 10, 2014. Motion to approve the report by Craig Wilson and seconded by David Sale.**

**Deputy Chief Fisher gave the Chief's report I addition to the regular report that is on file with the Clerk, Deputy Chief Fisher reported that \$381,589.00 had been expended from the 2014 budget. That amount is 53.3% of the budget. Motion to approve the report by Craig Wilson and seconded by Robert Ferioli.**

**Motion passed.**

**Deputy Chief Fisher said that the check from the sale of the Fire Alarm Truck has been deposited. The final repair bill for the truck has not been received at this time.**

**The 2013 compilation report from Cayer & Caccia has been received. Motion was made by Craig Wilson and seconded by David Sale to approve the report. Motion passed. A copy of the report is on file with the Clerk.**

**Deputy Chief Fisher and Ernest Lacombe attended the State of Rhode Island Department of Revenue meeting. The next meeting will be on July 31, 2014.**

**Discussion was held on the parking problem that often exists on Walker Avenue near Chapel Street. When vehicles are parked on**

**both sides of the street it is often very tight and could be a problem for fire and rescue vehicles to get through. Deputy Chief Fisher said that the Public Safety Committee will be notified of the Fire Department needs.**
