PUBLIC HEARINGS

1) 7:00 pm Public Hearing for CDBG 2012

The Town of North Providence is considering the filing of an application for a Rhode Island Community Development Block Grant. A maximum of \$4,584,872.00 estimated to be available statewide to undertake the following range of activities:

a) Improved housing opportunities for low and moderate income families and individuals.

b) Provision of employment opportunities for low and moderate income persons.

c) Provision of community facilities and services principally benefiting low and moderate income families and individuals.

A public hearing will be held at 7:00 pm on Monday, February 13, 2012 in the Assembly Room, at North Providence Town Hall, 2000 Smith Street, North Providence, RI for the purpose of obtaining the views of citizens on community development and housing needs and on program performance. This meeting room is accessible to the handicapped.

2) 7:15 pm, following the completion of the public hearing for CDBG 2012, Public Hearing for CDBG—Disaster Recovery.

The Town of North Providence is considering the filing of an application for a Rhode Island Community Development Block Grant—Disaster Recovery. A maximum of \$8,488,476.00 is available statewide to undertake the following range of activities related to the recovery of the floods in the March 12-31, 2010 disaster in the

following areas.

- **Relief from Disaster created needs**
- **Long Term Recovery Projects & Planning**
- **Infrastructure Improvements**
- **Restoration & Rehabilitation of Housing**
- **Economic Revitalization in affected areas**

The Town of North Providence is considering applying for infrastructure and related improvements in the vicinity of Gillen Avenue and Lojai Boulevard, and for infrastructure and related improvements in the vicinity of Winona Street and Rosedale Street.

A public hearing will be held at 7:15 pm (following the public hearing in Agenda item #1, whichever is later) on Monday, February 13, 2012 in the Assembly Room, at North Providence Town Hall, 2000 Smith Street, North Providence, RI for the purpose of obtaining the views of citizens on CDBG- Disaster Recovery needs and proposed activities. This meeting room is accessible to the handicapped.

Motion was made by Ted Garille, seconded by Henry Riccitelli, it was voted unanimously to endorse both items as presented for CDBG 2012 in parts one and two as listed on the agenda.

Motion was made by Ted Garille and seconded by Dan Connors to send a letter of support from the Planning Board of Review.
