The follow was discussed:

 - a. Attorney's and Mr. Donolan have reviewed the complaint.

 - i. Signatures and Registration records were printed out and reviewed.

 - b. Diana Pearson stated that the signature is sufficient to satisfy the states requirement.
 - c. Board agrees that the signature is sufficient.
3. Review and possible action on objection to Representative District 22 signature validation.
 - a. Mr. Metts attested that all the signatures in question, were signed in his prescence.

 - a. Next meeting tabled.
