**Discussion took place with respect to the Use of Property Requests. First was the Yoga Class for Teachers/Staff. Members offered comments regarding the fact that there is a charge for the class. Mr. Iannetta spoke about the policy regarding activities where there is a charge for the services and the updated policy states that there will be a charge for the Use of Property. Superintendent Smith spoke**

about the hourly charge of \$50.00. Members felt that the policy should be enforced. Next was the Whelan Elementary School After School Karate. Superintendent Smith spoke about the event being sponsored by the PTO and the money going to the PTO. Members felt that there should not be a charge for the use of property based the event benefiting the PTO. Next was the KR Baseball Academy at Birchwood Field. Mr. Milazzo spoke about the organization and explained that the request is to use the field when the leagues are not using it. Members felt that there should not be a charge for the use of property based on their in-kind services.
