

**State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations
Public Utilities Commission**

Minutes of Open Meeting Held January 9, 2013

Attendees: Chairman Elia Germani, Commissioner Mary Bray, Commissioner Paul Roberti, Cindy Wilson-Frias, Amy D'Alessandro, Alan Nault, Dilip Shah, Nicholas Ucci and Luly Massaro. Staff Patricia Lucarelli and Sharon Colby Camara were not present.

Chairman Germani called the open meeting to order at 10:00 A.M. in the first-floor hearing room of the Public Utilities Commission. A quorum was present.

Minutes of Open Meetings held November 19, 2013, December 6, 2012 and December 10, 2013: After review, Chairman Germani moved to approve the minutes. Commissioner Bray seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. Vote 3-0.

Competitive Telecommunications Service Providers

The following company filed an application for authority to transact as Competitive Local Exchange Carrier. The Division has reviewed the application and recommends approval of:

- 4381 – Zayo Group, LLC**

After review, Commissioner Bray moved to approve the application. Commissioner Roberti seconded the motion and the motion was

unanimously passed. Vote 3-0.

The following companies submitted tariff revision to their existing rates. The Division has reviewed the tariff filings and recommends that they be allowed to go into effect without suspension.

- 2262(O2) – NOS Communications, Inc. (tariff filing 12/28/12)**
- 2262(P2) – NOSVA Limited Partnership (tariff filing 12/28/12)**
- 2262(Q2) – Affinity Network, Inc. (tariff filing 12/28/12)**
- 2262(P1) - Working Assets Funding Service, Inc. (tariff filing 12/11/12)**

After review, the Commission followed the Division's recommendation that the tariff filings be allowed to go into effect without suspension.

The following companies ceased operations and requested that their authority to operate be rescinded:

- 3053 - 360networks (USA), Inc.**
- 2803 – AboveNet Communications, Inc.**

After review, the Commissioner Bray moved to rescind and recall the authority to operate as requested. Commissioner Roberti seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. Vote 3-0.

4379 – Verizon Rhode Island – The Commission considered Verizon's December 20, 2012 tariff filing to increase rates of various grandfathered services in the company's Local and Regional Package Services. The Division submitted a recommendation that the filing

be allowed to go into effect. After review, Commissioner Bray moved to approve Verizon's tariff filing. Commissioner Roberti seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. Vote 3-0.

2379(W2) – Clearview Electric, Inc. – The Commission considered Clearview Electric's November 27, 2012 application for authority to operate as a Gas Marketer. The Division recommended approval of the application. After review, Commissioner Bray moved to approve the application. Commissioner Roberti seconded the motion and motion was unanimously passed. Vote 3-0.

4311 - SREC Generating Company, Inc. for Steuben County Landfill Generation Unit – The Commission considered the Company's application for certification of the Steuben Landfill Generator, a 3.2 MW Biomass Facility located in Bath, NY, as an eligible New Renewable Energy Resource. The Commission's Consultant submitted a review and recommendation to approve. After review, Commissioner Bray moved to approve the application. Commissioner Roberti seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. Vote 3-0.

4237 – National Grid – Discussion of this docket was postponed until next open meeting scheduled January 31.
