Minutes of Open Meeting Held March 14, 2013

Attendees: Commissioner Mary Bray, Commissioner Paul Roberti, Patricia Lucarelli, Cindy Wilson-Frias, Alan Nault, Dilip Shah and Luly Massaro. Chairman Germani and staff Amy D'Alessandro, Sharon Colby Camara and Nicholas Ucci were not present.

Commissioner Bray called the open meeting to order at 1:00 P.M. in the first-floor hearing room of the Public Utilities Commission. A quorum was present.

Competitive Telecommunications Service Providers

The following companies submitted tariff revision to their existing rates. The Division has reviewed the tariff filings and recommends that they be allowed to go into effect without suspension.

- 2618 – AT&T Corp. (Tariff filings 3/1/13)
- 3008 – New Edge Network, Inc. (Tariff filing 3/1/13)
- 2736 – Conversent Communications of RI, LLC (Tariff filing 3/1/13)
- 2878 – Choice One Communications of RI, Inc. (Tariff filings 3/1/13)
- 3036 – CTC Communications Corp. (Tariff filing 2/28/13)
- 2262(D5) – DeltaCom, Inc. (Tariff filing 3/1/13)
- 2262(G1) – Business Telecom, Inc. (Tariff filing 2/27/13)

After review, the Commission followed the Division's recommendation that the tariff filings be allowed to go into effect without suspension.

4375 – Blue Jay Wireless, LLC – The Commission reviewed Blue Jay Wireless' December 6, 2012 Petition for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) for the purpose of offering lifeline wireless service on a wireline basis. The Division submitted a position indicating that it has reviewed Blue Jay's petition and recommended. After review, Commissioner Bray moved to approve Blue Jay Wireless' Petition for ETC Designation. Commissioner Roberti seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. **Vote 2-0.**

4392 – Pascoag Utility District – The Commission reviewed Pascoag's February 21, 2013 proposed LED Street Tariff Advice Filing to revise existing RIPUC No. 605 Public and Private Lighting Rates. The Division filed a memorandum indicating that it has reviewed the filing and recommended approval subject to Pascoag's incorporating clarification language to the proposed tariff. Pascoag subsequently filed on March 8, 2013 a revised LED Street Tariff incorporating the Division's recommendation. After review, Commissioner Bray moved to approve Pascoag's tariff with modification for effect April 1, 2013. Commissioner Roberti seconded the motion and the motion was unanimously passed. **Vote 2-0.**
