Mr. Sheehan said he would like to congratulate all of the administrators and teachers, especially Mr. Townsend, Mr. Monti, and Mr. Vigeant with regard to the opening of school this year.

Mr. Sheehan said before the first day of school on Tuesday, Mr. Townsend, Mr. Monti, and Mr. Vigeant were working on Friday afternoon, Saturday, and Sunday to make adjustments to some very important things including the new Kindergarten program at Greenbush and consolidating the 4th grade program at Wakefield Hills and sending children to Horgan.

Mr. Sheehan said that he couldn't be more impressed with the way that Mr. Townsend handled transportation. Mr. Sheehan said Mike Petrarca had been doing it for 27 years but he did a great job of coaching and teaching the ropes. Mr. Sheehan said at the same time, he knows Mr. Townsend relied on Mr. Vigeant and Mr. Monti. Mr. Sheehan said he thought it was very smooth for the first time— Mr. Townsend did a great job.

Mr. Sheehan said well done to all of the administrators—he wishes it didn't rain the first day and we probably could have had a little more supervision at the middle school when the kids got off the bus, but in the afternoon and the next day, it was perfect. Mr. Sheehan said it was a very good opening, and everyone came to school and went home on the right bus.

30. School Committee Discussion for the Good and Welfare of the School System

School Committee Discussion for the Good and Welfare of the School System

Mr. Williamson reminded the administrators that we will start monthly reports next month, and Mr. Sheehan will put out an e-mail regarding that.

Mr. Townsend said he knows we have been receiving complaints about the walk from the complex. He said the biggest complaints are that kids are walking in the rain. He said the gutters are falling and water is collecting in the divots. Mr. Townsend said he has contacted Peter Ethier by phone to fix the gutters, but he has not heard anything. He said in a week he will write a letter to the Town Manager. Mr. Florio asked he only rents it, right? Mr. Townsend said he leases it, but he said he would take care of it.

Mr. Townsend said there is another issue: Peter Ethier has rented out the field house for the next 10 days which creates an issue for us with the Physical Education classes—had been under the impression that this was for three days and this will only become an issue because there is a storm coming at us tomorrow. He said he had talked to Peter about it today—we pay to use that so the gym classes can use

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that. He said that we also have an alternative program that also uses that for Physical Education. He said he told him in the future we will need something in writing sent to the Superintendent when we are being displaced. He should advise us before signing a lease. He also advised him we will be discussing this with the Town Council if it happens in the future. We need that facility for gym classes. Mr. Sheehan said there was also an increase of 25% this year with regard to that least; we are paying \$18,775 to lease that facility for Phys. Ed. Classes, not for him to sublet to someone else so we can't go in.

Mr. Murphy asked was there was even an emblem in the rink to show the Magiera name. Mr. Kortick said that there is a sign in front and a banner.

Mr. Florio said that walking from the complex parking lot, a parent called him, even if they fix the gutters, there would still be a problem with the rainwater coming off the roof; it drenches the kids when they walk by. Mr. Florio said he thinks we should look into getting those gutters repaired—he thinks the town is responsible or Peter Ethier. Mr. Townsend said we have to give Peter a couple of days. Mr. Florio said that the lady who called him transferred her child from Father Doyle to the middle school and she is enthralled and said he is getting a better education that at Father Doyle. She had nothing but kudos to say about the school department, but she says her son comes home from school soaked and walked around all day like that—it's a legitimate complaint.

Mr. Florio noted that David Lussier has been named to the Alumni Board at Providence College. Mr. Lussier said he has been active for the past year at Providence College. He said he enjoys working with the alumni—it's a great honor.
