

Beach Commission Minutes of April 14, 2009

In Attendance: Bill Seiple, Dave Leys, Helen Flynn, Rian Wilkinson, Tom O'Loughlin, Shawn Brown, Frank Bozyan, Tim Shaw

- 1. Approved minutes March 10, 2009 – No changes**
- 2. Meeting with Harbor and Mooring Commission – S. Ponte.**
 - a. All mooring applications have been mailed and there are approximately 73 on the waiting list.**
 - b. Harbor management plans are in its' final approval stage, with only some questions on pump out capacity.**
 - c. Beach Commission recommended that the per diem rate for the town's moorings be set at \$20.00. Rian will forward this recommendation to Shawn Brown. Also, the town is looking into an on-line mooring-booking system.**
 - d. Renters will be advised that mooring-sharing is not allowed.**
- 3. Clean Ocean Access – passed to future meetings.**
- 4. Invasive Grass Eradication**
 - a. The town has awarded a contract and spraying will begin in. Late April – Early May - the spray will be colored and will have an adhesive to reduce blowing. This will be the first of 3 applications.**
- 5. Electricity – Third Beach – It was decided that a solar light will be installed at the boat ramp. A hard-line underground line would be too expensive at this time.**
- 6. Correspondence – Del's Lemonade- The Beach Commission recommended that the 2008 addendum to the Del's contract be extended through 2009. This allows a small food- cart to be stationed**

at “the rock”. Fees remain unchanged. Rian will forward this recommendation to Shawn Brown

7. Ordinances updates – Rian – Shawn - All ordinances: Kite Surfing, Hunting and Beach Protection had their first town council ready- no objections to any of the proposed ordinances – Final reading 4/20/2009.

8. Overnight R.V. Parking – Second Beach- Shawn Brown/ Tim Shaw will contact Police Chief Pesare concerning his recommendation on overnight RV Parking at Second Beach.

9. Meeting Change- The next Beach Commission meeting has been changed to 5/19/09 from 5/12/09.

New Business

- Bill Seiple asked Tom O to look into the flooding problems at the Third Beach Parking lots. This flooding causes loss of parking spaces and revenue.
- The Beach Commission recommended that Town Administrator Shawn Brown negotiate all beach concessions for the 2010 and 2011 option years. Rian will forward that recommendation
