

Beach Committee Minutes, May 19, 2009

- 1. Approved minutes from April 14th meeting , no changes.**
- 2. The beach commission supported Bruce Long's plan to have a small concession cart at Third Beach. It would be run through the Del's contract and serve hot dogs, soda's etc. This would be a service that the beach commission supported for years.**
- 3. R.V. parking at Second Beach- still being studied. The main concern is night security at the Second Beach parking lot. Steve Ponte suggested using the Third Beach boat ramp lot as an alternative. Security would be easier due to the single gated entrance. Also, entrance and exit would be less complicated. This topic will be revisited at the 6/09/09 meeting.**
- 4. Trash Removal- Second Beach- Citing safety concerns (trucks on a crowded beach) and ease of trash removal. Tim C. and the recreation dept suggested a plan where most trash barrels would be on the parking lot side of the dunes. This allows for safer and more efficient trash collection. Additional barrel will be situated around the concession stand. The Beach commission supported the new beach trash collection plans**

5. Council ordinances- Rian praised the Town Council and town administrator for their support of Beach Commission recommendations concerning beach protection, kite surfing regulations, and hunting on town beaches. All three ordinances were passed without dissent.

6. Review of the 2009 project list. With only a few exceptions, the entire list was completed. Others will be completed during the 2009 season. All major items were completed including invasive grass elimination, building repairs, and updating ordinances.

7. New Business- Literature from the R.I. CRMC/DEM was distributed. It prohibited unlimited passing down of family mooring rights.
