### **High Lights**

- All paths would have Mobi Mats, which require, almost, no maintenance and can be adjusted, as needed.**
- All paths would have diagonals at their beach exit point. These paths will run counter to the prevailing winds and should reduce dune erosion.**
- The project will involve extensive planting. Dune grass and Heather.**
- A vehicle, only, path- #5-located west of the main building, will be constructed. This will be a service path and will, safely, separate beach patrons and town vehicles.**
- All paths will be graded to facilitate dune conservation and patron convenience.**

**The Beach Commission, unanimously, approved the plan after brief questioning. Rian suggested enlarging the dune grass budget and checking if snow fence could, also, be included in the proposal.**

**The recommendation will be forwarded to the town council for review.**

#### **4. New Business**

- **Tom O'loughlin reported that the proposed deck at the main building was not supported by CRMC.**
- **Rian reported that beach commission member, Gary Lapidas, has moved to Florida and will have to resign. The position will be advertised by the town. Gary was a member for several years and will be missed.**
- **Will Cronin informed the beach commission that NFW will begin work in the Third Beach area. Initial construction to be completed by the beach opening and finished later in the year.**
