Dr. Ambrogi indicated that the Underwood SALT visit resulted in a very favorable SALT report. Dr. Ambrogi indicated that the SALT visits had become a casualty of the current state financial crisis and will no longer be supported with funding by the State Department of Education.

Dr. Shoemaker indicated that a Liaison Subcommittee has not met.

6.3.2 Policy.

Subcommittee Chairperson Mrs. Gaines reported that the "Pass/Fail" policy will be presented for second reading tonight from the Ad Hoc Committee on Academic Eligibility. Also presented tonight will be a change to the Kindergarten Early Admission procedures for first reading.

6.3.3 Wellness.

Mrs. Gaines reported that there was no wellness meeting.

6.3.4 Rhode Island Association of School Committees (RIASC).

Dr. Shoemaker reported from the most recent RIASC Committee Chairs meeting.

6.3.5 Substance Abuse Prevention Task Force. Mr. Carlin reported that the Task Force is continuing work on combating underage drinking in Newport.

6.4 Meeting with RIDE Representatives (June 23rd).

Dr. Shoemaker reported that he has been in touch with Mr. Robert Camara, a member of the Board of Regents. Mr. Camara chairs the Finance Committee, which oversees the New School Construction program. Mr. Camara will respond to written questions. Please forward any questions to Dr. Shoemaker who will forward them to Mr. Camara.

6.5 200th Anniversary of Abraham Lincoln's Birth.

Mr. Carlin and Dr. Ambrogi have discussed a coordinated K-12 curriculum activity in commemoration of the 200th anniversary of Abraham Lincoln's birth. The Rhode Island Abraham Lincoln Bicentennial Commission will be sponsoring an Institute for Rhode Island Teachers to enable teachers, at any grade level, to bring to their classrooms a new knowledge of Lincoln during and after the celebration of the bicentennial.

7.0 ACTION.

7.1.1 Academic Eligibility for Participation in Extracurricular Activities – Second Reading

Mr. Carlin moved to accept for Second Reading, the Academic Eligibility for Participation in Extracurricular Activities policy change as presented. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Gaines. Discussion was held. Mr. Carlin will rework the paragraph numbered 2, to include language about the student's eligibility on all reports to the student. Paragraph number 4 under the Special Education Students section will be re-worked to correct punctuation. A companion administrative policy which would contain procedures for reporting eligibility status to students and regular reporting to the school committee will be presented to the committee with the third reading. After discussion the motion was approved (4-2) with Mr. Leary and Mr. Phelan opposing the motion.
