

SPECIAL MEETING NORTH SMITHFIELD TOWN COUNCIL

DECEMBER 7, 2012

The meeting was called to order at 6:46 P.M. Council members present were Ms. Alves, Mr. McGee, Mr. Zwolenski and Mr. Flaherty. Mr. Yazbak was unable to attend due to business commitments.

Attorney James J. Lombardi III interviewed for the position of Town Solicitor as well as for the Municipal Court Judge if the council felt he could be helpful in that position.

Second to be interviewed was Robert V. Rossi for the position of Probate Court Judge.

The final interview for the evening was Kenneth Amoriggi who was interested in all four positions of Town Solicitor, Assistant Town Solicitor, Municipal Court Judge and Probate Court Judge. During the interview it was discerned that Mr. Amoriggi would not be qualified for the position of Town Solicitor based upon qualifications listed in the Town Charter.

APPOINTMENT OF TEMPORARY ASSISTANT TOWN SOLICITOR
