I. CALL TO ORDER

A meeting of the Scituate Land Trust was held on Tuesday, November 14, 2006, and was called to order at 6:30 P.M. It was held in the School Department Meeting Room, Scituate Town Hall, 195 Danielson Pike, N. Scituate, Rhode Island.

III. EXECUTIVE SESSION:

The Land Trust went into executive session from 6:35 to 7:00 pm. to discuss properties in the thralls of land acquisition.

IV. REGULAR SESSION:

Discussion on the proposal that went to DEM for grant money allocated for development. There was also some discussion on the proposal to purchase development rights on several parcels located in the Chopmist Hill section of town.

The Scituate Soccer Association submitted a proposal to revamp Tasca Field. The comments were as follows:

- 1. Drainage to the back as opposed to go towards the wetland on Route 6.**
- 2. Entertain putting in composting toilets as opposed to a septic system.**
- 3. Porous surfaces for parking.**
- 4. Angle parking.**
- 5. Talk to Providence Water about a right of way to utilize for emergency vehicles.**

The Angeli's (guests) who abut Lawton Farm came in to discuss surfacing the right of way at Lawton Farm. They were told they could gravel the driveway after clearing the stones that they dumped on the right of way. They were also told that they could no longer cut any vegetation on Land Trust property.
