Motion was made by Charles R. McCaughey and seconded by Norma Knox to accept the minutes of June, 18, 2009 unanimously voted to accept.

APPLICATIONS

Myrna R. Moore- DBA Just Myrna Floral Designs & More- 174 Danielson Pike-Plat 19 Lot 51- Signage. Applicant would like to install an eighteen (18) inch by ninety -six (96) inch sign above the porch roof. The sign colors will be ivory with hunter green outlining. Sacha asked if applicant was going to have an additional sign on the free standing pole. Mrs. Moore said due to budget concerns she would only put up a small open sign. Mr. John Eramian would be building the sign.

George Myrick forwarded an email stating his concerns about the application not being completely filled out. Chairman Robert Knox also stated that there was an error on the application, listing the applicant as the owner of the property.

Motion was made by Charles R. McCaughey and seconded by Mark Laprade to accept the application as presented, unanimously voted to accept.

Sacha Anthony Hummel also questioned the interior "sign" in the window at Charming Treasures in reference to zoning regulations. Chairman Knox stated that it's legally not a sign.
