

**Chairman Robert S. Knox called to order a meeting of the North Scituate District Review Committee (VDRC) on December 17, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. Members present were Norma Knox, Sacha Anthony Hummel and Mark Laprade. Barbara S. Stetson, Charles R. McCaughey and George Myrick were absent.**

**Motion was made by Norma Knox and seconded by Sacha Anthony Hummel to accept the minutes of November 19, 2009, with correction, unanimously voted to accept.**

### **OLD BUSINESS**

**Norma Knox informs committee members that the new Baptist Church sign is up. She also looked into the exact location of the shed being built at 97 Danielson Pike. She stated that the shed is located behind the house and she feels that the Overlay should have no say in the design of it. Chairman Robert S. Knox feels the same way. The Building Official had inquired if the committee felt that this shed design come before the committee.**

### **OTHER BUSINESS -CORRESPONDENCE**

**Motion was made by Mark Laprade and seconded by Norma Knox to authorize payment of the Xerox bill for 2009, unanimously voted to accept.**

**Motion was made by Norma Knox and seconded by Sacha Anthony Hummel to accept the meeting schedule for 2010, unanimously voted to accept.**

**Chairman Knox received a letter stating that the approved budget for 2009-2010 listed as one thousand three hundred seventy five dollars (\$1,375). He disagrees with amount saying that the approved budget**

for 2009-2010 was one thousand six hundred ninety one dollars (\$1,691). He questioned whether an error was made confusing the North Scituate Village Overlay Committee with the Hope Overlay Committee budget.

Norma Knox wondered if the town reduced the budget without notifying the committee.

Motion was made by Mark Laprade and seconded by Norma Knox to accept the Budget 2010-2011 as level funded in the same amount, one thousand six hundred ninety one dollars (\$1, 691), as the previous budget 2009-2010, as the committee members never received written notification of a change.

#### **GENERAL DISCUSSION**

Chairman Knox asked Sacha Anthony Hummel how the Village Stroll went. Sacha stated that some store owners weren't following the rules of the "official trolley stops". Chairman Knox discussed the carolers. Norma Knox and Mark Laprade discussed the parking issue of cars parked on both sides of Silk Lane.

Motion was made by Mark Laprade and seconded by Sacha Anthony Hummel to adjourn at 7:45 p.m., unanimously voted to accept.
