

**A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was called to order at the Chopmist Hill Senior Center, Chopmist Hill Road, Scituate on Friday, December 17, 2004 at 8:45 AM. This meeting was to be held at the Chopmist Hill Fire Station.**

**Members present were Chief Mack, Richard Iverson, Robert Budway, Gerald Round and Edwin Rogers. Deputy Chief Collins was not in attendance.**

**Motion made by Edwin Rogers, seconded by Robert Budway and voted to accept the minutes of March 19, 2004 meeting.**

**Motion made by Robert Budway, seconded by Edwin Rogers and voted to accept the minutes of September 19, 2004 meeting.**

**Chief Mack read the letter that was sent to the residents of Frosty Valley (see copy herewith). Chief Mack stated that he has not heard any comments regarding this letter. Richard Iverson noted that a mirror was posted in Frosty Valley as suggested at the 9/19/04 meeting.**

**Motion made by Richard Iverson, seconded by Gerald Round and voted to accept the 2005 meeting dates and locations with the change of 12/16/05 meeting to be held at the Chopmist Hill Senior Center.**

**Chief Mack welcomed Edwin Rogers who was appointed by the to**

**this committee by the Town Council.**

**Chief Mack noted that Deputy Chief Collins researched driver feedback signs as the ones posted in West Warwick on Wakefield Street. Robert Budway has suggested posting driver feedback signs on route 116 north and south of Hope Elementary School. After discussion, Richard Iverson suggested writing a letter to the State Department of Transportation exploring the possibility of installing these signs. This issue will be discussed once response from the State is received.**

**Edwin Rogers questioned the location of signage on Rockland Road near the Scituate High School. Mr. Rogers explained that the State law requires signs be posted 300 feet from any exit/enter of a school. Chief Mack asked Richard Iverson to obtain plans for the placement of these signs and forward copies to this committee for discussion.**

**Edwin Rogers noted concern with the Scituate High School track team running in the roadway on Central Pike. Gerald Round explained that he would forward this concern to Superintendent Paul Lescault.**

**Motion made by Richard Iverson, seconded by Robert Budway and voted to adjourn the meeting at 9:15AM.**
