

A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was called to order at the Chopmist Hill Senior Center, 1315 Chopmist Hill Road, Scituate on December 16, 2005 at 8:40 AM.

Members present were Chief Mack, Robert Budway Gerald Round and Ed Rogers. Richard Iverson and Deputy Chief Collins were not in attendance.

Motion made by Ed Rogers, seconded by Gerald Round and voted to accept the minutes of the September 16, 2005 meeting.

Next on the agenda was discussion of the tabled request from Mr. Caprio for a stop sign at Water Valley Road and White Birch Circle. Chief Mack stated that clerk Hopkins contacted Mr. Caprio's office and left message as to the committee suggesting that he bring letters of support to this traffic meeting. An agenda was also sent to Mr. Caprio, he was not in attendance. All members agreed to table this discussion until the March 17, 2006 meeting.

Motion made by Gerald Round, seconded by Ed Rogers and voted to accept the meeting dates for 2006. (see copy herewith)

Chief Mack referred to letters received by Mrs. Forte, 240 Bungy Road, Scituate. Chief Mack stated that clerk Hopkins was unable to locate a phone number to contact Mrs. Forte but an agenda was sent by mail. Mrs. Forte was requesting a speed bump to control the rate

of speed in that area. Ed Rogers explained that the Towns insurance company is against speed bumps. All members agreed that speeding is a universal problem and patrols would be increased in that area.

Chief Mack noted that all members were re-appointed at the December council meeting. Discussion followed on how many members were required to be on this committee. Clerk Hopkins will look into that for the next meeting.

Brief discussion occurred on the possible removal/relocation of the gate blocking Institute Lane.

Motion made by Richard Iverson, seconded by Robert Budway and unanimously voted to adjourn at 9:15 AM.
