

A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was called to order at the Scituate Council Chambers, 195 Danielson Pike, N. Scituate on June 15, 2007 at 8:31 AM.

Members present were Chief Mack, Gerald Round, Richard Iverson and Captain Randall. Robert Budway and Ed Rogers were not in attendance.

Motion made by Richard Iverson, seconded by David Randall and voted to accept the minutes of the June 15, 2007 meeting.

Richard Iverson explained the issue of student parking on Trimtown Road. He stated that he has worked with Sgt. Pendergast and the issue has been resolved. An announcement was made to all students of no parking on Trimtown Road. Chief Mack request this be put on the agenda for the September meeting when school reconvenes.

Chief Mack referred to letter received by Chief Ellis of the Potterville Fire Department requesting signage at the intersection of Tunk Hill Road and Matteson Road. Captain Randall stated that since 2004 there have been 7 accidents and 1 fatal on May 6, 2007. All members agreed to send a letter to the State DOT requesting they have an engineer review the area and submit suggestions.

Captain Randall explained that complaints have been received from residents in the area of Brandy Brook and Central Avenue due to

trucking. Richard Iverson noted that there is no thru trucking on Brandy Brook but is allowed on Central Avenue. He also stated that speed limit signs are being posted today on Brandy Brook.

Motion made by Gerald Round, seconded by Richard Iverson and unanimously voted to adjourn at 8:42 am.
