

A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was called to order at the Scituate Council Chambers, 195 Danielson Pike, N. Scituate on June 20, 2008 at 8:34 am.

Members present were Chief Mack, Captain Randall, Gerald Round, and Ed Rogers. Councilman D'Agostino and Dale Langlais were not in attendance.

Motion made by Captain Randall, seconded by Ed Rogers and voted to accept the minutes of the March 28, 2008 meeting.

Chief Mack stated that he does not see a problem with speed bumps on Silk Lane as long as they are removed in the winter months. Gerald Round commented that if the snowplows go slow they could keep them there year round. Dale Langlais was not in attendance to discuss this issue further.

Chief Mack referred to letter received from the State Traffic Commission approving our request to reduce the travel lanes between the horseshoe dam and Rockland Road from four lanes to two. A study is being performed to determine the speed limit for the village. Ed Rogers stated new pedestrian signs have been posted. The Stated forwarded our request for fire station warning signs to the RIDOT.

Motion made by Captain Randall, seconded by Gerald Round and

unanimously voted to adjourn at 8:45 AM.
