

**A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was called to order at the Scituate Council Chambers, 195 Danielson Pike, N. Scituate on December 19, 2008 at 8:35 am.**

**Members present were Colonel Randall, Ed Rogers, Dale Langlais, Councilman D'Agostino and School Committee member Mary Lou Umbriano. Deputy Chief Lang was not in attendance.**

**Motion made by Gerald Round, seconded by Councilman D'Agostino and voted to accept the minutes of the September 20, 2008 meeting.**

**Colonel Randall asked Dale Langlais, Director of public works his opinion of speed bumps in the town. Dale explained that he was under the understanding that the trust would not support the town if speed bumps were erected. Colonel Randall asked Dale to contact the trust and have them reply in writing their opinion of speed bumps.**

**This discussion will be tabled until the March 20, 2009 meeting.**

**Motion made by Councilman D'Agostino and seconded by Ed Rogers and voted to accept the meeting dates for 2009.**

**Next on the agenda was school bus issue. Colonel Randall suggested that this discussion be tabled until Sgt. Pendergast could be in attendance. This will be added to the March 20, 2009 meeting.**

**Colonel Randall read a letter received from Potterville Fire**

**Department (see copy herewith) stating that there are no traffic signs in the Oakwood Plat. Colonel Randall asked patrol to draft a map of the area. He explained that there are no stop signs on Oakwood Drive, Cara Court and Brett Drive. Colonel Randall reviewed the ordinance for stop intersections and those streets are not listed. He then asked public works director Dale Langlais to review those areas and return to this committee in March with a recommendation.**

**Next on the agenda were reappointment/ appointment of this committee. Colonel Randall stated that Town Clerk Peg Long faxed him the Traffic committee policy. This policy explained that the committee would consist of one Town Council member, the Chief and Deputy Chief of Police, Director of Public Works and Assistant Director of Public Works with a quorum of three. At the traffic meeting on 2/2/1987 the committee asked the Council to amend the committee policy to include a tax payer. Gerald Round was appointed as a tax payer to the committee at that time. Colonel Randall stated that Town Clerk Long suggested advertising this position rather than appointing a liaison from the school committee.**

**Motion made by Colonel Randall, seconded by Councilman D'Agostino and voted to seek advertisement for this committee as suggested by Town Clerk Long.**

**Under general discussion Colonel Randall asked clerk Lisa Hopkins to check with the town clerk's office regarding the web site not listing**

**the correct members. Clerk Hopkins stated she would speak with Gloria Loyd.**

**Ed Rogers suggested sending a letter to Gerald Round thanking him for his 21 years of service to this committee. Councilman D'Agostino stated he would contact Council President Budway on the procedure that should be taken.**

**Motion made by Ed Rogers, seconded by Councilman D'Agostino and unanimously voted to adjourn at 8:54 AM.**
