

A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was called to order in the Scituate Council Chambers, 195 Danielson Pike, N. Scituate on December 18, 2009 at 8:33 am.

Members present were Colonel Randall, Major Lang, Marylou Umbriano, Richard Tucker, Dale Langlais and Councilman D'Agostino.

A motion made by Marylou Umbriano, seconded by Major Lang and unanimously voted to accept the minutes of the September 18, 2009 meeting.

Colonel Randall read a letter received from Jeffrey Hanson, Chairman of the Scituate Plan Commission explaining intersection Improvements for Spruce Valley Drive/French Lane (see copy herewith). David Provonsil showed two schemes, A and B (see copy herewith). All members agreed that scheme A would be better for traffic.

A motion made by Marylou Umbriano, seconded by Councilman D'Agostino and unanimously voted to recommend scheme A to the Plan Commission. A letter will be sent to the Plan Commission.

Colonel Randall explained that he spoke with Dr. Campbell and agreed to keep most of his parking towards the building with the exception of 3 vehicles on the Danielson Pike portion of the lot.

Colonel Randall welcomed Richard Tucker to the committee, stating he was appointed at the past Council meeting. He also noted that all other members have been re-appointed.

Next on the agenda was discussion of a letter sent by Deputy Chief Chevalier, Hope-Jackson Fire Co. requesting additional signage on

Hope Furnace Road (see copy herewith). Dale Langlais stated that he agreed with Deputy Chevalier and the signs have been posted.

Colonel Randall read a letter received from Debra Bartley, Rocky Hill Road requesting that a mirror be replaced that was posted on Elmdale Road(see copy herewith). Dale Langlais stated that the mirror had been replaced and the town does not recommend speed bumps.

Colonel Randall stated that Town Clerk Long sent a letter to the State Department of Transportation, Engineering Division requesting slow children signs be posted in the area of North Scituate Elementary, but DOT declined the request with an explanation that under federal guidelines signs are not appropriate for such areas on state roads.

Motion made by Major Lang, seconded by Councilman D'Agostino and unanimously voted to adjourn at 9:01am.
