

A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was called to order in the Scituate Council Chambers, 195 Danielson Pike, N. Scituate on Friday, June 17, 2011 at 8:34 am.

Members present were Colonel Randall, Marylou Umbriano , Richard Tucker and Deputy Chief Lang. Councilman D'Agostino and Dale Langlais were not in attendance.

After pledge of allegiance to the flag a motion was made by Marylou Umbriano, seconded by Deputy Chief Lang and unanimously voted to accept the minutes of the March 11, 2011 meeting.

The Colonel asked Deputy Lang for an update on Route 6 and Elmdale intersection. Deputy Lang explained that Sgt. Lang has been in contact with the DOT garage in Gloucester. He recommended that this committee write a letter of request. Colonel Randall stated that he would send a letter and asked Clerk Hopkins to put it on next agenda.

Mr. Sparling, 484 Field Hill Road, Clayville was in attendance. Mr. Sparling explained his concern with speeding on Field Hill Road. He stated that his wife has stood in the road handing out flyers to vehicles. Colonel Randall asked that she not do that and we can work together to control this issue. He suggested creating a neighborhood group to work together. Colonel Randall explained that the police will have patrols in the area, park the speed trailer and asked Mr. Sparling to notify him of the specific time of day and vehicles that have been speeding. Marylou Umbriano told Mr. Sparling that she is a school committee member and will put this on the next agenda. She also suggested that he contact Eric Croce who is charge of

Scituate/Foster little league to get a message out to parents traveling Field Hill Road for games.

Under general discussion Colonel Randall explained that he has spoken with Town Engineer, David Provonsil in regards to the proposed Tractor Supply building that will be opening at route 102 near the route 6 bypass. Colonel Randall wrote a letter to the Chairman of the Zoning Board stating his safety concerns. He did receive a letter from Hallisey, Pearson & Cassidy Engineering Associates (see copies herewith). This will be placed on the next agenda for discussion.

Richard Tucker informed the committee that the town will be paving Pine Hill Road, Peeptoad Road and Lady Slipper.

Motion made by Richard Tucker, seconded by Marylou Umbriano and unanimously voted to adjourn at 9:05am.
