

A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was called to order in the Scituate Council Chambers, 195 Danielson Pike, N. Scituate on Friday, January 18, 2013 at 8:32 am.

Members present were Colonel David Randall, Marylou Umbriano, Councilman David D'Agostino and Deputy Chief Stephen Lang. Bob Dexter, Director of Public works was not in attendance.

After the pledge of allegiance to the flag a motion was made by Deputy Lang, seconded by Marylou Umbriano, and unanimously voted to accept the minutes of the September 21, 2012 meeting.

Motion made by Deputy Lang, seconded by Marylou Umbriano and unanimously voted to accept meeting dates for 2013.

Motion made by Councilman David D'Agostino, seconded by Marylou Umbriano and unanimously voted to accept re-appointment of all members.

Colonel Randall stated two letters were received from the State Traffic Safety Commission in response to traffic safety concerns in the area of East Road/Scituate Ave and Rockland/Trimtown Road. The letter dated October 26, 2012 noted that the intersection of East Road/Scituate Avenue will change to a four way stop, also changing yellow flashing lights to red. This will be completed within the next few years. The letter dated December 26, 2012 regarding Trimtown/Rockland Road was not approved for a four way stop. Stating that the flow of traffic on Trimtown Road as it is crossing Rockland Road does not meet the criteria. (see copies herewith).

Colonel Randall mentioned Town Clerk Long voiced concerns with the intersection of Brandy Brook Road/Central Ave. Colonel

explained that he will speak with Bob Dexter, Director of Public Works to determine if any line of sight issues. He also asked Deputy Lang to have patrols survey the area in regards to speed and truck traffic. Deputy Lang will also bring crash data for that area to next meeting. Colonel Randall asked clerk Lisa Hopkins to add Brandy Brook Road/Central Ave to next meeting agenda on March 15, 2013.

Motion made by Marylou Umbirano, seconded by Councilman David D'Agostino unanimously voted to adjourn at 8:45 am.
