

A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was called to order in the Scituate Council Chambers, 195 Danielson Pike, N. Scituate on Friday, March 21, 2014 at 8:35 am.

Members present were Colonel David Randall, Marylou Umbriano, Bob Dexter, Kris Gregory, and Deputy Chief Stephen Lang, Councilman David D'Agostino was not in attendance.

After the pledge of allegiance to the flag a motion was made by Marylou Umbriano, seconded by Kris Gregory, and unanimously voted to accept the minutes of the 12/20/13 meeting.

Colonel Randall referred to letter he wrote to Richard Conca P.E., RIDOT 1R Highway Improvement Program regarding Winsor Avenue. (see copy herewith)

Colonel Randall received a letter from State of RI Traffic Commission in regards to the three crosswalks and parking on West Greenville Road between the North Scituate Congregational Church and Silk Lane. (see copy herewith)

Marylou Umbriano stated that she will be requesting an assembly with the High School Body to go over the Breathalyzer policy. She also mentioned graduation will be held on June 13th, Prom will be on May 17th in Newport.

Colonel Randall explained that the Town Engineer, David Provonsil received information on the Federal Funded Round About Program, once he reviews the information received he will then contact this committee for discussion.

Bob Dexter stated that the "No Thru Trucking" signs have been received and will be posted once the weather becomes warmer. He

also mentioned that street sweeping operations will begin soon. the High School lots are scheduled to be done on April 5th.
