

**A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was called to order in the Scituate Council Chambers, 195 Danielson Pike, N. Scituate on Thursday, June 18, 2015 at 8:30 am.**

**Members present were Colonel David Randall, Lt. Eric Rollinson, Kris Gregory, Marylou Umbriano and Bob Dexter. Councilman David D'Agostino was not in attendance.**

**After the pledge of allegiance to the flag, a motion was made by Marylou Umbriano, seconded by Kris Gregory and unanimously voted to accept the minutes from the March 19, 2015 meeting.**

**Old Business, Colonel Randall met with Town Engineer David Provonsil and representatives from RI DOT in regards to sections B – F of this agenda.**

**B. Colonel Randall showed map of Route 116 from Coventry – Smithfield stating the proposed speed limit sign locations.**

**C. Funding for Danielson Pike project will be sought out in July 2016 through the State and August 2016 for federal funding. The project is set to begin in 2017. Colonel Randall noted that a one mile area in the vicinity of RI State Police Barracks will be the priority.**

**D. Central Pike and Route 102 high risk area will be checked into, Town Engineer David Provonsil gave the work order # to RI DOT.**

**E. This committees concern were forwarded to RI DOT in regards to the proposed Elmdale area roundabout.**

**F. Suggest to lower speed from 50 to 45 in area of Gorham Field, no time line given on this project.**

**Under New Business, Bob Dexter stated that the “No Thru Trucking “ signs that had been posted on Hope Furnace Road are no longer**

**there.**

**Bob Dexter contacted DOT regarding a 6 inch drop in pavement on Gleaner Chapel Road approaching from the South.**
