

**A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was called to order in the Scituate Council Chambers, 195 Danielson Pike, N. Scituate on Thursday, September 22, 2016 at 8:34 am.**

**Members present were Colonel Randall, Captain Rollinson, Kristen Gregory, Marylou Umbriano and Bob Dexter. Councilman David D'Agostino was not in attendance.**

**After the pledge of allegiance to the flag, a motion was made by Marylou Umbriano, seconded by Kristen Gregory and unanimously voted to accept the minutes from the 06/16/16, meeting.**

**Agenda item II. B, RIDOT Roundabouts; Colonel Randall stated we have not received any current updated information and asked it to be put on December 15, 2016, agenda.**

**Agenda Item VI. A, passing lane concern; Colonel Randall referred to letter received from Henry Rosciti Sr, 1324 Chopmist Hill Road, Scituate (see copy herewith). Colonel Randall explained that after reviewing the area he agrees with Mr. Rosciti's concerns and would like to send a letter to RI State Traffic Safety Commission requesting the removal of the passing lane on Route 102 between the intersection of Route 6 and Central Pike.**

**After discussion a motion was made by Robert Dexter, seconded by Marylou Umbriano and unanimously voted to allow Colonel Randall to correspond with STSC to eliminate the passing lane on Route 102, between the intersection of Route 6 and intersection of Central Pike**

**Under general discussion Colonel Randall explained that he is working with RI State Traffic Safety Commission to eliminate the passing lane on Plainfield Pike eastbound from Dorr Road to the**

**Town of Johnston line. Another location under discussion is Route 116, which is missing signage and reducing the speed limit approaching the school zone coming North from the Town of Coventry line.**

**Motion made by Marylou Umbriano, seconded by Kris Gregory and unanimously voted to adjourn at 8:45am.**
