

A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was called to order in the Scituate Council Chambers, 195 Danielson Pike, N. Scituate on Thursday, March 16, 2017 at 8:34 am.

Members present were Chief Delaere, Deputy Chief Rollinson, Kristen Gregory and Councilman Michael Payette. Councilman David D'Agostino and Richard Tucker were not in attendance.

After the pledge of allegiance to the flag, a motion was made by Kristen Gregory, seconded by Deputy Chief Rollinson and unanimously voted to accept the minutes from the 12/15/16 meeting.

Chief Delaere asked Clerk Hopkins to note new members, Councilman Michael Payette and Carolyn Dias into the record.

Agenda item II. B, RIDOT Roundabouts; Chief Delaere read email received by Steven Pristawa, RIDOT (see copy herewith) stating the roundabouts are in the RIDOT's 10 year plan for 2020.

Agenda Item II. C, Chief Delaere read an email received from Steven Pristawa, RIDOT (see copy herewith) stating passing zone on Route 14 is too short and they are preparing a work order to modify striping.

Agenda III. New Business, Councilman Payette stated he received concerns on the area of Elmdale and Rocky Hill Road. He questioned if this could be made into a 3 way stop. After discussion, Councilman Payette explained that he would speak to Richard Tucker and continue this item to next Traffic Safety agenda.

Councilman Payette suggested a traffic light at the end of the Route 6 bypass where it intersects with Route 101. After discussion, it was agreed Chief Delaere would speak with Steven Pristawa to see if the potential roundabout in that area would help the need for a traffic

light.

Motion made by Councilman Payette, seconded by Kristen Gregory and unanimously voted to adjourn at 8:52am.
