

**A meeting of the Traffic Safety Commission was called to order in the Scituate Council Chambers, 195 Danielson Pike, N. Scituate on Thursday, September 21, 2017 at 8:47 am.**

**Members present were Chief Delaere, Deputy Chief Rollinson, Kristine Gregory, Public Works Director Richard Tucker, Carolyn Dias and Councilman Payette. Councilman David D'Agostino was not in attendance.**

**After the pledge of allegiance to the flag, a motion was made by Kristine Gregory, seconded by Deputy Chief Rollinson and unanimously voted to accept the minutes with corrections noted from the 06/15/17 meeting.**

**Chief Delaere addressed resident Robert Fishman, 576 Central Pike, who had a question in regards to the construction signs posted on Central Pike. Chief Delaere stated he spoke with Steve Pristawa, RI State Traffic commission who confirmed that they will be flashing beacons posted on Route 102 in the area of Central Pike.**

**Chief Delaere introduced June Gugliemli and John Morgan who are representing Trinity Church in regards to the proposed Rapid Flash Beacon to be posted on Danielson Pike in the area of the crosswalk in front of the church (see information herewith). They asked for this committee to approve this proposal to be submitted to the RIDOT, they explained that the church will pay for installation and the state has agreed to maintain. After discussion motion made by Councilman Payette, seconded by Carolyn Dias and unanimously agreed to approve the RIDOT Physical Alternation Permit Application, with a letter from this committee supporting the installation of the**

## **Rapid Flash Beacon.**

**Agenda item II. B, striping of Hope Furnace Road. Public Work Director Tucker explained that the striping on Hope Furnace Road has been completed.**

**Agenda item II. C, Stop sign at Hope Avenue. Motion made by Richard Tucker, seconded by Councilman Payette and unanimously agreed to recommend to the Town Council that Hope Avenue be added to the current stop sign ordinance.**

**Agenda item II. D, Stop line at exit of student parking lot. After discussion a motion made by Carolyn Dias, seconded by Kristine Gregory to recommend to the School Committee a stop line be painted at the exit of the student parking lot adjacent to Trimtown Road and changing the existing stop sign to a 36" stop sign.**

**Agenda Item III. New Business, Deputy Chief Rollinson stated that Mill Street has been an issue with parking, tickets have been written. Deputy Rollinson suggest Mill Street be one side parking only. Motion made by Richard Tucker, seconded by Kristine Gregory and unanimously voted to recommend to Town Council that Mill Street be one side parking, once the Police Department has determined which side would be best due to the location of fire hydrants.**

**Deputy Chief Rollinson suggested cones being posted at crosswalk on Danielson Pike in area of the Town Hall and N. Scituate Post office.**

**Chief Delaere stated he would contact the RIDOT in regards to the process of having them posted.**

**Agenda IV. Correspondence, Chief Delaere spoke with Stephanie Mayville, Danielson Pike regarding her concerns, signage has been**

**posted and she is satisfied with the results.**

**Next on the agenda was request from Councilman Izzi for a stop sign at Ben Brown Ave. After discussion all members agreed to recommend to council. Motion made by Richard Tucker, seconded by Carolyn Dias and unanimously agreed to recommend to the Town Council that Ben Brown Avenue be added to the stop sign ordinance.**

**Deputy Chief Rollinson stated that he attended the RI State Traffic Commission meeting in regards to Hartford Pike/Elmdale Road. Deputy Rollinson explained that this area is still under discussion in regard to the proposed turnabout, they are proceeding to do a traffic study to determine the need in that area.**

**Linda Deluca, 206 Howard Ave, Hope explained concerned in her email (see copy herewith). All members agreed that this location does not warrant a stop sign. Richard Tucker stated he would look at the area in regards to any missing signage and replace as needed.**

**Kristine Gregory asked if the December meeting could be changes to Friday, 12/22/17 at 8:30, all members agreed.**

**Motion made by Richard Tucker, seconded by Kristine Gregory and unanimously voted to adjourn at 9:47 am.**
