Dear Chief Perry:

This office represents Peter W. Schofield, Sr., President of the Snug Harbor Volunteer Fire Association. Mr. Schofield has spoken to me and I have checked with the South Kingstown Police as to your actions on March 26, 2012 where you have made a complaint to the South Kingstown Police regarding language of Mr. Schofield allegedly directed towards you. As a result, you requested a no trespass order be issued by the South Kingstown Police barring the chief officer of the Snug Harbor Volunteer Association from going on any Union Fire District property. You did such action in your capacity as Chief of the Union Fire District and also in your individual capacity.

Your action is in direct contravention of the duties of Mr. Schofield, Sr. acting as President of the Snug Harbor Volunteer Fire Association. Such actions by you belong in the realm of the civil law and not criminal law. You have chosen to utilize the South Kingstown Police. I would suggest you rescind your complaint. If you do not do so by Monday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012, suit will be brought against you personally and in your capacity as Chief of the Union Fire District for injunctive relief and damages.
