

**MINUTES OF REFUSE COMMITTEE MEETING
OF THE
MISQUAMICUT FIRE DISTRICT**

March 23, 2005

Moderator, Peter J. Przekop, called the Refuse Committee meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. on March 23, 2005.

District Officers Neil Collins and John Toscano were also in attendance. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the refuse contract bid from EZ Waste Systems, Inc. with Mr. Chris Beck. EZ Waste Systems, Inc. was the low bidder for the Misquamicut Refuse Collection contract. The bids were opened at the March 17, 2005 District officer's Meeting. Mr. Beck was asked to make a presentation regarding EZ Waste Systems, Inc. and how his company would accomplish the Misquamicut Fire District Refuse Collection should he be awarded the bid. Mr. Beck discussed the use of smaller trucks utilizing dumpsters to collect the trash. The contents of these dumpsters would be periodically transferred to a larger compacting truck. Mr. Beck was aware of the back yard pick-up stipulation in the contract and the necessity to complete Winnapaug Road and Atlantic Avenue sections early in the summer months to avoid traffic problems.

The committee also discussed other options such as a three-year award with an option for the remaining two years at the \$81,400 price.

The committee will report to the District Board that EZ Waste Systems, Inc. is capable of meeting the requirements of the Misquamicut Fire District Refuse contract. The District Board will

then decide the award of the contract at the April 21, 2005 District Officer's Meeting.
