Only Art, Lee, Jean and I got together tonight. Main topic of discussion was the erosion on the North beach. I have been in contact with the Town engineer but have not met with him yet. Hope to do that this week. Will ask him his opinion of how to curb or stop the erosion taking place on our beach. Did talk to highway dept. but they claim there is nothing they can do with the curb to stop drainoff.

The other discussion was regarding Erik and his constant wave making. We would like you to write a letter on behalf of the ILSFD Association to Erik stating the regulations on Page 3 of the ILSFD handbook under Residence (at the bottom of the page) articles 1, 2, and 3. We have written to him before but I didn't think we had copies of any of the letters or proof that Erik ever received them. (After Jean went home, she called to say she had copies of 2 letters sent him, but we still don't have the proof. Would you have receipts with his signature?) Anyway it was decided without proof of his receiving letters in the past, we should start the process again. We would like you to write him a letter, return receipt requested, asking him to stop using a surfboard, shovel, or any other articles (he has made a new wooden contraption to make waves) to make waves and redistribute sand on the beach area and in the lake.
