

# **Indian Lake Shores Fire District Council Meeting**

**January 9, 2007**

## **I. Secretary's Report:**

**The minutes from the November 2006 meeting were presented and accepted unanimously on a motion made by Arthur Novsam and seconded by Karla Steele.**

**Uncollected Taxes \$5916.39**

**The uncollected taxes represent about 15% of the monies due. There**

are 20 delinquent taxpayers of which 16 are homes. 2 of the delinquent taxpayers are two years in arrears.

The delinquent bills will be sent out this week. A 12% fine, as clearly printed on the original tax bills sent out in October, will be imposed. The properties that are two years in arrears will be put up for tax sale if taxes and interest are not paid within a month.

The only outstanding bill is the insurance for the ILSFD Directors and Officers Policy for slightly more than 1K. It will be mailed tomorrow.

The Treasurer's report was accepted unanimously on a motion made by Penney Hanson and seconded by Esther Diggins.

### **III. Old Business:**

1) The North Beach has been surveyed and staked by the surveyor. A few of the council members have checked where the stakes were placed. Arthur Novsam, Kevin Donahue and Paul Giarrusso will meet on Sunday morning to take pictures. The entire council will inspect the properties in the spring.

2) Boats at the Docks: There are still a few canoes left at the docks. If they are still there this weekend they will be taken up to the exits of the plats and a sign hung on bulletin boards stating that they boats were unmarked and abandoned at the ILSFD properties.

**3) Rotten Tree: SK Highway notified of a rotted tree located about 40 feet in from Arrow Head Trail on Indian Trail South. They checked and stated the tree was on private property.**

**4) Alisha Diggins was in a car accident in November. The family wants to thank their neighbors and the council their help and caring. Alisha is on crutches and healing well. She will suffer no permanent injuries from the accident.**

**1) There was an inquiry made about giving quotes for insurance. It was forwarded**
