Tree damage from Winter Moths need to get more information
Water Shed Overlay – Planning Board requested input from Conservation Commission pertaining to a private home requesting to screen in deck on second floor – no plumbing, no bedroom, or need to increase septic. All agreed that we did not see a problem with this plan.
Work on in ground tanks and check state regulations
- VI. Old Business :
Earth removal – quarrying – hydrologist's letter – Extent of quarrying is beyond what he can do – we need a geo-hydrologist to evaluate the problem/need to meet with Matt and determine type of rock that is being removed but do they have right to place ground and drinking water in jeopardy by removing legal rock. Quarrying is also too deep.

Tiverton Crossings – legal challenge against planning board.

Four Corners – on hold until August. Plan for protecting well heads, septic systems – waste water plan and enforcement

Well water testing results from URI well water meeting - one third of water tested had chloroform

Annual Report is being worked on.

Sign Ordinance – July 13th or 14th hearing.

Comp Plan – still a work in progress

Glen Crossing/Mall – Water availability and management of waste water still a major question. What will be the cost of infrastructure?
