## **Minutes of Meeting of Supervisors**

**September 25, 2006 at 6:00 PM**

**Casino Building, 23 8th Avenue, Warwick, RI 02886**

**Attendees: J. Suffredini, B. Remick, J. Taton, K. Mason**

### **Budget Update:**

**We're on track with current budget. Tax receipts coming in as expected. Fire District paid for net and backboard for tennis, as we have in the past. Joe will meet with property tax assessor regarding items in the casino.**

### **Ground Maintenance & Improvements:**

**Received quote from Bill Ross on snow removal. Joe will compare it to last year and, if increase is reasonable, will sign contract.**

**Trees have been removed from the BBA property near Dawn Era's home.**

**Peter Dorsey will send out a letter to residents to ask them to contact Chris Cronin of Beta Engineering with any leftover items. Negotiations are ongoing with Beta and Rocchio regarding the**

**damaged trees. Fire District paid for an independent assessment, which confirmed that repair work was needed. Bob will get an update from Peter.**

**We discussed a tree project for next year, including the idea of Adopt-a-Tree. Judi will ask about expanding a group of residents from the garden club to take an active role in planning for new trees and plantings when the sewers are finished next spring.**

### **Casino Restoration:**

**Ken will have a price for the door next week. He'll talk with Dave Falaguerra about the leaks in the roof.**

### **Security:**

**One more gate security scheduled for Halloween night to deter damage to property. Judi will call BV to schedule an earlier start time.**

### **Other:**

**Supervisors' calendar – Field clearing tabled until next spring. Ken will talk to Casino Committee to shut off water, phone, etc. Due to extended use of the Casino, Judi will arrange to add 4 more weeks of trash management.**

**Ken distributed a memo to advise neighbors that parking in triangle and other BBA properties should be used for emergencies.**

**Catch basin on Promenade and Hemlock appears to be sinking. Ken will contact Bill Ross to investigate.**

**Alarms – Joe will contact the company for inspection of the system and will discuss the recorded messages regarding the low temperature sensor.**

**Ken will assume responsibility for compliance with Open Meetings Laws and postings.**
