Minutes of Meeting of Supervisors

Budget Update:

No Treasurer's Report

Ground Maintenance & Improvements:

Ken Mason contacted Bill Ross to repair sunken manhole on corner of Promenade Ave. and Hemlock, cost estimated to be \$1200 - \$1500.

Large tree with severe rot on Buttonwoods Ave. was damaged extensively during the recent storm. Bill Ross has given us a price of \$650 to remove all fallen branches in the neighborhood. Bob Remick will ask Bill if he can also remove the remainder of the rotted-out tree and grind the stump

Bob Remick received a question from a resident regarding trimming

bushes. Resident would need approval from owner and BBA. CRMC approval may also be required, depending on location. Bob will communicate to resident.

Request received from resident to install a barrier to prevent cars from driving into the grassy area at end of Lorna. Drivers at night are not able to see that the paved street ends. Letter has been received from the Warwick Sewer Authority approving the barrier. Judi will inform resident.

Ken reported that the best price for repairing and repainting the signs at the entry is the \$900 per sign from Forge. We agreed to table this item until the spring when we have better budget numbers.

Casino Restoration:

Ken has a price of \$350 - \$400 from Gene Tougas to reverse the back door and repair the frame. He will also ask Gene to repair the broken windows. Ken will ask the Treasurer if there is any leftover trim paint.

Question of replacing screens on the windows was tabled until the spring when the budget is clearer.

Security:

Gate security will be provided for Halloween night from 6:00 PM until Midnight.

New Business:

Two functions have been added to the Casino schedule. Judi will arrange trash management for those dates and have barrels washed and brought inside.

Ken will arrange for winterizing the casino plumbing.

The next meeting will be rescheduled to November 20th at 6:00 PM at the Casino. The December meeting will be cancelled, barring any emergency.
