A new guardrail has been installed at the end of 8th Ave.
The water fountain was fixed by the tennis court.

A RFP will be put out for the refurbishing of the restrooms in the Casino.

The trash barrels next to the tennis courts will be removed for the season. One reason for this is that there is no one to empty these until the summer. Therefore they quickly fill with debris, especially *dog droppings* and sit there for months. We will be adding this duty for the summer months to those children that are hired to empty the trash for the summer. An addition \$5.00 in pay was recommended for this service.

Speed -The supervisors have received numerous complaints regarding vehicles driving in excess of the posted speed limits in the neighborhood, especially along Buttonwoods and Promenade Avenues. The speed limit on Buttonwoods Avenue is 25 mph, and changes to 15 mph at the second speed bump. The speed limit on all the other roads within the Buttonwoods community is 15 mph as posted, so please drive slowly, and remind all the drivers in your household to maintain these speed limits for the safety of all.
