**Minutes of March 7, 2006 meeting accepted as written. There was no meeting held by EPHMC for the month of April, 2006.**

**Old Business:**

**1. There was some discussion on the update of the Bullocks Cove dredging project. It appears that the City of East Providence will be**

responsible for securing \$50,000 in an account before the Bullock Coves dredging project can continue. This share of funding will have to be put into a CRMC account no later than November, 2006 to continue with this dredging project. The \$50,000 allocation was approved at the June 1, 2004 meeting of the City Council. Communication will be forthcoming as new developments occur. As for the Pawtuxet Cove site, it seems that the dredging has been completed and satisfied by ACOE but is awaiting approval from the Coast Guard.

2. All of the City's Public Right of Way's have been visited with a brief summary of the general conditions of those sites. The location listings and conditions were distributed amongst members of the EPHMC and Harbormaster's department and reviewed. Some photos were also distributed to get a general idea of the site condition from both the land and water's edge. Some more photos will have to be taken and a suggestive report will be made soon as soon as we are able to update the existing format.

3. Nothing to report on the status of proposed ordinance changes. Harbormaster Dufresne and Mr. Bieberbach are waiting to get the inspection stickers from DEM.

**New Business:**

**1. Chairman Murray received a copy of the ACOE filing application for the dredging of Bullock Cove.**

**2. The EPHMC did not send out any official correspondence.**

**4. It was reported by Frederick Bieberbach and Bruce Dufresne that the CRMC Harbor Management Plan workshop they attended was very well put together. A copy of CRMC Municipal Harbor Management Plan Consistency Determination Checklist and Guidelines for the Development of Municipal Harbor Management Plans is on file with the EPHMC and Harbor Department.**
