Comments: Steve Pristawa stated a traffic signal on Metacom Avenue at the intersection with Jameson Drive does not meet warrants. 85th percentile was 40 and 41 MPH with average speeds of 35 and 37 MPH. A study was performed and the highest number of vehicles exiting in one year was 29 vehicles, 13 pedestrians crossed at this location in a 12 hour study and there were 14 crashes over 3 years. Steve also mentioned that the Town of Bristol has a new Planner and was inquiring about a center turn lane. Chief Mello said Metacom Avenue is not wide enough for a 3rd lane. Bob Rocchio said usually every 25-30 years roadway reconstructions should be considered and Metacom Avenue probably will be coming up in about 10 years and that maybe then changes can be made to the number of lanes.

Comments: A crosswalk was denied in the vicinity of 2325 Boston Neck Road due to low pedestrian crossings and high vehicle speeds. The road is 40 feet wide with a speed limit of 35 MPH. 85th percentile is 41 MPH and average speeds were 39 MPH. Bill Corson stated that he was surprised the speeds weren't higher, as he knows people travel at 50 plus MPH. Bill also asked to see if more open parking in the back field is available and Meredith Brady stated the back field is full. Chief Mello stated that some of the burden needs to go back to Casey Farm and that maybe their traffic detail can aide pedestrians crossing for the Farmers Market in addition to helping traffic exiting the farm. Meredith Brady also stated that the Farmers Market usually puts out signs which has slowed down some of the vehicles. A pedestrian count was taken on a Thursday and no pedestrians crossed and 11 pedestrians crossed on a Saturday due to the Farmers Market.

Comments: Paul Bannon of Beta Group spoke on behalf of the Town of Johnson and Citizens Bank. Mr. Bannon spoke regarding installing a traffic signal on Greenville Avenue for the new driveway opening to the Citizens Bank campus located at 685 Greenville Avenue. Mr. Bannon stated that approximately 3200 employees would be working at this location with over 2400 parking spaces available. He said approximately 1100 vehicles per hour will be coming into the campus for morning peak hours and 1.000 vehicles exiting the driveway in the afternoon peak hours. There would be 2 double left lanes exiting out of the campus. Mr. Bannon stated that 75% of employees will be driving from the South of I-295. Bob Rocchio asked if the off-ramp will be signalized and Paul Bannon said yes, but that this signal would be submitted under a different PAPA along with the new interchange. Bob Rocchio asked regarding a roundabout instead of a traffic signal and Paul Bannon said that would have wetland impacts and would require to take some residential homes in the area. Northbound off-ramp on I-295 will have a dual left turn lane and the ramps will be 2,000 feet in length. Paul Bannon said the traffic signal at the end of the ramp will be the master control and will monitor all traffic signals. Steve Pristawa said usually with 2 interchanges normally there are 2 traffic signals and not just one. Paul Bannon said that they will propose to have all conduit/infrastructure in place for the south off-ramp and that FHWA is reviewing the Environmental Assessment and hopes to hear back from them within the next couples of months. Bob Rocchio made a motion to approve a traffic signal at the new driveway to 685 Greenville Avenue with the stipulation that Citizens Bank is constructed at this location.
