The group toured the Cumberland High School Transitional Building and High School Main Building, North Cumberland Middle School, Community Elementary School, McCourt Middle School and B.F. Norton Elementary School.

Classrooms, Hallways, Cafeterias and Exteriors were examined. Windows, Ceiling Tiles, Heating and Ventilation Units, Fire Alarm Panels and Asbestos Floor Tiles were discussed as specific areas of need.
