Jerry Squatrito, chairperson, introduced himself to the board. He will chair all future meetings with the information provided to him by the Division of Occupational Safety.

Ben Anthony, Chief Boiler Inspector, presented several facts to the board including the late fee charged on delinquent invoices, and fines charged for not obtaining permits prior to installations and repair of boilers. Mr Anthony stated his position and he is requesting
