Mr. David Burnham called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Mr. Burnham made a motion to accept the minutes as recorded of the December 12, 2006 meeting. Mr. Ellery Wood seconded the motion. All members voted in favor.

Hearing Carriglio Construction Corporation

1. Mr. Steve Lazarro and RIDLT Investigator, David Rodrigues are present today to provide testimony and have been previously been sworn in by the stenographer.

Mr. Burnham read the violation: Location of violation was Millwork Company, Lot 57 Business Park Drive, Smithfield, RI. On Thursday, August 17, 2006, Mr. David Rodrigues, Chief Hoisting Engineer Investigator did witness an employee, Rafael Juitires, of Carriglio Construction Corp. using a forklift without a license under RIGL 28-26-12 and had no OSHA license.

Mr. Steve Lazarro reported that Rafael Juitires was not an employee, nor was he on the payroll of Carriglio Construction Corporation.

Mr. Burnham made a motion that a finding of fact has been made by the Board that, a violation of RIGL28-26-5 did occur but to suspend the fine in the amount of one thousand one hundred fifty dollars (\$1,150) for a 12-month period barring any violation of RIGL 28-26-11 during that period, seconded by Ellery Wood. All members voted in favor. Second motion was made by Ben Anthony to recommend to the Director that the fine of \$1,150 be suspended. Ellery Wood seconded the motion. All members voted in favor.

Other Business

The Director, Ms. Adelita Orefice, of the Department of Labor and Training, addressed the Board.

The Director would like to have vacancies filled for the Workforce Development office, and Trade Occupation Boards at the Department of Labor and Training. The Director will be starting with the Trade Occupation Boards within the next couple of weeks. The Director would like to have reappointments and vacancies filled first. Once resumes are submitted and the vacancies have been filled, training will take place. Any suggestions or feedback are welcome to her at any time. The Director introduced David Tremblay, who has been brought to the Department of Labor and Training to do both Federal and State legislative work.

Mr. Burnham made a motion to adjourn at 10:45 a.m. Mr. Wood seconded the motion. All members voted in favor.
