Mr. Benjamin Anthony, Acting Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 10:05 am.

There was a Quorum today.

Benjamin Anthony asked if everyone had a chance to review the minutes of our July 10th meeting. Ellery Wood, Jr. made a motion to approve the minutes from July 10, 2007 meeting, and John Shaw seconded the motion. All Board members were in favor.

There were three hearings that were tabled from July's Board meeting for recommendation to the Director for today, since there was not a Quorum at our July 10th meeting, the stenographer's transcript was forwarded to all Board members to review the facts and testimony given at our July 10, 2007 Board meeting. During this Board meeting a recommendation will be made to the Director of Labor and Training, Adelita Orefice, regarding Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company (#3139); Edward J. Rolland (#3187) and Carlisle Building Systems, Inc. (#3188).

1. Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company - #3139

Witnesses, David Rodrigues, John Buretta, who was there on behalf of Tennessee Gas Pipeline, and Edward Rolland who were sworn in by the Board Stenographer at our July Board meeting. Acting Chairperson, Mr. Benjamin Anthony, asked the Board if they had read the transcript of our July 10, 2007 meeting. The Board proceeded with the violations that were tabled.

Based on the facts and testimony presented at our July 10, 2007 meeting, and after review of the Board stenographer transcript, Ellery Wood, Jr. made a motion to suspend the violation No. 3139 for a 12-month period pending any further violations. Kathy Serrecchia seconded the motion. All board members were in favor.

2. Edward J. Rolland - #3187

Based on information and testimony that was given at our July 10, 2007 Board meeting, and after further review of the transcript, John Shaw made a motion that a fact did occur and that the violation No. 3187 in the amount of \$300 be suspended for one year and then dismissed if there are no further violations. Ellery Wood, Jr. seconded the motion. All board members were in favor.

3. Carlisle Building Systems, Inc. - #3188

Based on previous testimony and facts brought before the Board at our July 20, 2007 meeting, and after reviewing the Board stenographer transcript, Woody Ellery, Jr., made a motion that a fact of finding did occur and that the fine of \$600 is upheld and that a recommendation be made the Director. John Shaw seconded the motion. All board members were in favor.

There were no further hearings for today.

Old Business:

Learner's permit was tabled to our next meeting in October. All Board members were in favor.

Woody Ellery, Jr. made a motion to adjourn. John Shaw seconded the motion. Meeting was adjourned at 10:15.
