The meeting was called to order at 9:21 am by Stanley Davies.

Mr. Davies welcomed Sean Nolan

Hearings:

Both violations were heard together (Daniel Terrelli, #4021 and Anthony Venticinque, #4022). Daniel Terrelli, Anthony Venticinque, Patrick Luther and Edward Whittaker are sworn in. Daniel Terrelli and

Anthony Venticinque were represented by Attorney Maureen Gemma.

1.) Daniel Terrelli (Violation # 4021): Edward Whittaker read the violation. Location of violation: 44 Harwood Ave, Cranston, RI. Violations: RIGL 25-27-5 “Practices for which a Master or Contractor License required”. On or about October 21, 2010 Mr. Daniel Terrelli MP002293 did enter into contract and install a steam boiler at the above address. Upon further investigation it was determined that Mr. Terrelli is not a licensed pipefitter in Rhode Island. This is a violation of the above referenced law. One violation at \$500.00.

2.) Anthony Venticinque (Violation # 4022): Benjamin Copple read the violation. Location of violation: 44 Harwood Ave, Cranston, RI. Violations: RIGL 28-27-21 “Grounds for revocation of license (3) (4)”. On October 21, 2010, Anthony Venticinque, Master Pipefitter #00001624, did take a permit in the City of Cranston for the installation of a steam boiler at the above location. The Mechanical Permit was taken out for Red’s Plumbing Mr. Daniel Terrelli who did the installation assisted by Mr. David Spaziano. This is a violation of the above revered law.

The Board questioned Mr. Whittaker. Attorney Maureen Gemma questioned Mr. Whittaker and Mr. Luther. Attorney Gemma questions Mr. Terrelli. A copy of Mr. Terrelli’s Apprenticeship card is put into evidence. The Board questions Mr. Terrelli and Mr. Venticinque. The Board requests to question Bernard Treml, Apprenticeship

Supervisor. Bernard Trembl is sworn in. The Board questions Mr. Trembl. Testimony continues from Mr. Terrelli and Mr. Venticinque. Mr. Luther addressed the Board. The Board again questions Mr. Trembl. Attorney Gemma again questions Mr. Terrelli.

Timothy Byrne made a motion that Violation # 4021 did occur, seconded by Dennis Brennan. Passed unanimously by the Board. Timothy Byrne made a motion that the fine of \$500.00 be upheld. Seconded by Dennis Brennan. Passed unanimously by the Board.

On Violation # 4022, Timothy Byrne made a motion that the violations did occur. Seconded by Dennis Brennan. The Board then had a discussion. A copy of the permit was made part of the administrative record. Timothy Byrne made a motion to amend the violation, that the violation of RIGL 28-27-21 (3) did occur. Seconded by Dennis Brennan. Passed unanimously by the Board. Timothy Byrne made a motion to amend the original fine of \$1,000.00 to \$500.00 which would be suspended for one year provided Mr. Venticinque has not further violation. Seconded by Dennis Brennan. Pass unanimously by the Board.

End of hearing.

Timothy Byrne recommended that Daniel Terrelli be found in violation of RIGL 28-27-5.1 "Practice for which a journey person or apprentice license required. Seconded by Dennis Brennan.

Timothy Byrne made a motion to adjourn and seconded by Michael Januario. Passed unanimously by the Board.

The meeting adjourned at 10:34 am.
