Public Comment:

Mr. Mike Alexander was present for public comment. Mr. Alexander stated that the pond at the Butterfly Garden/Chase Farm was cleaned by Mr. Alexander, Boy Scouts and volunteers. Mr. Alexander stated the pond was vandalized and a broken pvc water pipe resulted. Mr. Alexander added that the pvc water pipe needs to be replaced. Mr. Alexander added that \$52.00 is needed to replace the pvc water line valve. Commissioner Perrotti suggested to repair/replace the waterline and to approve the \$52.00 for the valve replacement. Mr. Alexander advised the Town of Lincoln to annually allocate approximately \$150.00 to have the town take over the expenses to maintain the water piping in the irrigation system.

Mr. Alexander provided an expense report including the sum of \$375.00 to have the pond cleared of much, dirt, etc. Mr. Alexander's landscape company is in the name of Pondsapes. Commissioner Goldman recommended to deny the \$375.00 to have the pond cleaned and suggested this issue to be placed on the next Conservation Commission meeting agenda scheduled for 6 July 2005.

A motion was made to put together a rotating schedule to attend Town Council meetings to discuss matters relative to environmental issues.
