RIGHTS OF WAY SUBCOMMITTEE

Meeting Minutes
October 24, 2006

The Rights of Way Subcommittee convened at 5:45 PM in the Board Room of the Narragansett Bay Commission, 1 Service Road, Providence, Rhode Island, at the call of member Paul Lemont. The Subcommittee designated John Longo, Deputy Legal Counsel, to take minutes.

1. The Subcommittee took up the Agenda item regarding proposed Rights of Way in Warwick. The Subcommittee voted unanimously to adopt the Attorney Reports regarding the Alger Avenue and Bradford Avenue waterfront access points and further to recommend the full Council designated them as Public Rights of Way.
2. The Subcommittee then took up the Agenda item regarding the Marine Avenue right of way in Newport, RI. The Committee had before it a fax from Attorney Turner Scott, addressed to Legal Counsel Brian Goldman, dated October 9, 2006, advising that he (Scott) and the attorney for an interested person, Joe Nicholson, were working to resolve the issues involved and were planning to meet with the Newport Cliff Walk Commission regarding the matter. The Subcommittee voted unanimously to continue the matter 1 month or until such time as the parties are ready to proceed by the end of this year.
3. There being no further business to discuss, the Subcommittee adjourned just before 6PM.
