AGENDA ITEMS:

1. High Street Right of Way-CRMC Legal Counsel briefed the subcommittee that he had received no appeal from the Superior Court decision affirming CRMC's designation of High Street as a right-of-way. Legal Counsel presented the subcommittee with a series of photographs depicting the right-of-way and a swing set that was in the middle of the right-of-way. The subcommittee voted unanimously to request CRMC staff to send an enforcement letter to the property owner regarding the swing set with removal by November 1st. In the event the swing set was not removed by November 1st the owner should be advised that the town of Jamestown would come in and remove said swing set.

There being no other business to come before the Rights-of-Way Subcommittee, the meeting adjourned at 5:55 p.m.
